Living to Serve Grants Chapter Visit Talking Points

Utilize these talking points to provide information about the available Living to Serve Grants to students and advisors at chapter visits.

TALKING POINTS:

- Living to Serve Grants are available to chapters that hold service-learning projects lasting one year or one semester and/or service events that take place over one or a few days.
- Living to Serve Grants support projects in one of four focus areas: Community Safety; Hunger, Health and Nutrition; Environmental Responsibility; and Community Engagement.
- Yearlong Living to Serve Grants are available for \$3,000 and are due June 15.
- Semester-Long Living to Serve Grants are available for \$1,200 and are due Sept. 1 for fall semester projects and Feb. 1 for spring semester projects.
- Day of Service Mini-Grants are accepted on a rolling basis and are due the last day of each month.
- All grant due dates are available at FFA.org/LivingToServe/grants.
- You apply online. The application is new and easy to complete. The application allows multiple collaborators to work on the same application.

- When conducting service, chapters should use #LivingToServe on social media to showcase what they are doing.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

- How many grants are awarded?
 - Grants are reviewed on a competitive basis. The number of grants awarded is dictated by available funds.
- How many grants can a chapter be awarded?
 - A chapter can receive either one Yearlong Living to Serve Grant or up to two Semester-Long Living to Serve Grants AND up to two Day of Service Mini-Grants.
- Does my service project qualify?
 - Email LTS@ffa.org. They can help you determine if your project meets the grant guidelines.
- Who can apply?
 - The Yearlong and Semester-Long Living to Serve Grants are available to high school/middle school chapters.
 - The Day of Service Mini-Grants are available to high school/middle school chapters and alumni/collegiate chapters.
