Event Safety

The following information will help you be prepared for your trip to convention this year.

BE SAFE

Remember to not leave items visible in vehicles or buses. If possible, leave items at your hotel or hidden in a trunk, locked case or under seats.

ENTRY INTO CONVENTION VENUES

IMPORTANT- The following items are not allowed in convention facilities – (this includes the Indiana Convention Center, Lucas Oil Stadium, Bankers Life Fieldhouse and Indiana State Fairgrounds). Items found during security checks for entry into some convention events will be taken if you choose not to return it to your vehicle or hotel. You will not be allowed entry with these items:

No knives

(of any type or size)

No weapons

Security Checks – A security check will take place at entry into convention venues (this includes the Indiana Convention Center, Lucas Oil Stadium, Bankers Life Fieldhouse and Indiana State Fairgrounds). Similar procedures found in airports today will be used during entry for many events in the venues. This will include bag checks, entry through metal detectors and or use of wands. Please note, this procedure is done for the protections and safety of our attendees.
